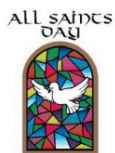

We are!! Hope that you are too!!! The ladies are making plans to gather and prepare several side dishes especially for Thanksgiving. We hope you are making an extra casserole and freezing it when you prepare meals for your family. Soups are popular also and freeze well and sell well.

Our annual Frozen Casserole Sale is Saturday November 21. We are asking each family to donate at least one of your favorite casseroles. It can be a side dish or you can make a main dish such as lasagna, baked spaghetti, something mexican or chicken & dumplings to mention a few possibilities.

We ask that your casserole be in an 8x8, 8x11, 7" round, or 9" round disposable foil container, **frozen solid** with a label that has the cooking instructions, the main ingredients, your name and phone number on it. All casseroles need to be in disposable aluminum pans. The ladies are furnishing pans which are available in the hall of the little church (Chapel) building. It is alright to use your own aluminum pans but please stay as close as possible to the sizes we mentioned. Freezer space is limited and uniform pans stack easier.
