5 Loaves 2 Fish Summer Food Program

What is it?

Mississippi has the worst hunger problem in America. Specifically, there are 729 elementary age children in Hernando that are food insecure. More than 1 in 4 children (28.7%) in Mississippi go to bed hungry most every night. Hunger is a problem all across America. But in Mississippi, it's practically an epidemic.

This program will feed 40 children throughout the summer with a breakfast and lunch meal. While the children are at school they get their meals furnished for them, but when school is out, what happens?

The Mid-South Food Bank is collaborating with local churches in Hernando that have accepted the challenge to address this problem by providing 40 children with a box filled with nutritious food that will feed them for two weeks. We are starting this as a test program for this summer with our goal to be able to expand our ministry to children and families in need in the following years.

Holy Spirit Parish is going to be a part of this and on June 21st at the Hernando United Methodist Church from 12 noon to 6 p.m. to first of all pack food boxes and then to help in the distribution of the boxes to the families that pick them up from 3:00 – 6:00 p.m. What a wonderful opportunity to continue to reach out to the poor and needy in our community. Thanks to all who have volunteered to be part of this wonderful program. If you have any questions, please call the church office and I will be happy to share more about this opportunity to meet the needs of the hungry children in our area.

How can I help? Volunteers are needed to pack the boxes and assist with the bi weekly food distributions. Sponsors are needed to pledge monetary donations to cover the cost associated with creating the food boxes. Holy Spirit will only be helping one time this summer, June 21.
