JEREMIAH

I spent my whole life trying to get my fellow countrymen to TURN AROUND, to turn back to God, to Return to the promises made to our God.

My call to prophesy came when I was just 22 years old. Of course, I had many excuses why I could not do what he asked, mainly that I was too young. Excuse not accepted. "See, I will put my words into your mouth" was His answer.

My purpose in life was to bring hope to my people, to get them to COME BACK to God, back to obeying HIS LAW. How difficult it is to remain faithful! And how much more difficult it is to live the consequences of Unfaithfulness!

I am Jeremiah. I did everything to get the message across. Once I smashed a clay jar to show how God would smash our nation and our city of Jerusalem if they did not pay attention. I walked through the streets wearing a yoke....the kind you put on oxento show what would happen if we didn't TURN AROUND and go back to God. Somebody else would put the yoke on us and lead us away!

In my time of history King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon had set out to conquer the smaller nations around him. Our king Zedekiah got caught up in politics, forgot his God and finally was conquered by the King of Babylon, who deported all the leading citizens and their families to Babylon in Iraq. Again my people became slaves

marching across the desert. They were in exile for many years before they could return to Israel.

I continued calling my people to return to God, to obey his law. I wept for them.

But God is faithful. He gave me a great message of hope. We hear it today.
